



## General Information

Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators (Core) tests are required for application to ECU's Partnership Teach model and later the Upper Division phase of the Teacher education programs at ECU. The 3 tests measure basic skills in **reading**, **writing** and **mathematics**. Students may take Praxis tests at computer testing centers around the state. Students should contact Educational Testing Service (ETS) at [www.ets.org/praxis](http://www.ets.org/praxis) to schedule and pay for required tests. Allow at least 20 business days (4 weeks) to receive scores.

## Passing Scores

Students may register for each of the three Praxis CORE tests separately, or they may register to take the Combined Test with all three sections offered in one session.

**A composite (total) score of 468 is considered passing for the full test.**

If scores on one or two tests of <i>Praxis</i> Core are less than the minimum, a composite score of 468 may be used.

**Take the Praxis after completing your required math if possible, but no later than October of the semester before your ECU application is due to allow time for scores to be reported.**

## Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

### Are there alternative testing locations?

The Praxis tests offers two testing options for testing. You can test at a testing center, or you can test at home with a remote proctor. ### Are Fee Waivers Available?

### Are there alternatives to Praxis CORE?

SAT and/or ACT scores can substitute for Praxis Core. (see page 1 for more information)

### Where can I find my SAT/ACT scores?

Check with your high school to see if scores are listed on your transcript. If not, contact the testing agency directly.

### Do I need to save my scores?

Yes. Even though you will send a copy to ECU, you will need to submit a copy of your scores with your Partnership Teach and Upper Division applications.

### What is the difference between the “Old” and “New” Praxis Core? Can scores be combined?

In Sept. 2019, ETS revised the content of the Praxis Core Math test. The new test has more of an emphasis on statistics and less on algebra and geometry although both tests include all three concepts. The Reading and Writing test codes changed, but the content did not.

**If your individual scores add up to 468 or higher you passed regardless of the status beside each test score. If you feel you did not perform to your potential, you may retake a *Praxis* test once every 21 days, not including your initial test date.**

### Notes:

- If asked, select North Carolina as the certifying state
- If asked for state agency, select NC DPI Teacher Licensure
- When selecting your testing date, keep in mind that scores are reported a minimum of 4 weeks after the test date.
- Identify your Attending Institution
  - Search East Carolina University (Code 5180). Select Yes when asked to send your scores.
- Your Score Recipients
  - NC DPI Teacher Licensure should be listed as an Automatic Score Recipient
  - East Carolina University should be listed as an Additional Score Recipient. ***Note: You will still need to download your .pdf test score report when available and include it with your Partnership Teach application.***
- Print your Admission Ticket and bring I with you to the test center on the day of testing.
