## Have you turned in your Application for Graduation?

- Connect with your program advisor to complete an application for graduation.
- Completed graduation applications must be turned in to Student Services no later than **FRIDAY, APRIL 15TH, 2022**.

## Have you ordered your graduation regalia?

- Access the link provided and enter “Pamlico Community College” to view graduation regalia and souvenirs.
- All graduation regalia is purchased online and shipped directly to your home. Caps and gowns are not mandatory for the ceremony but are encouraged. Graduation regalia cannot be purchased through our bookstore.
- The last day to order your graduation regalia online is **SATURDAY, APRIL 16TH, 2022** to ensure receipt in time for the graduation ceremony. Any orders placed after this date may incur additional fees from *Herff Jones*.
- It is your responsibility to purchase your items in a timely manner. Pamlico Community College is not responsible for late orders and cannot guarantee that we will be able to assist you in getting the appropriate regalia. Please contact Student Services ASAP if you miss the deadline.

## Graduation Requirements

Graduation exercises are conducted once a year following the spring semester. Additional ceremonies may be conducted as determined by the department or program. Credentials for prospective graduates must be verified by the program advisor.

- An application for graduation must be submitted to Student Services by **FRIDAY, APRIL 15TH, 2022**.
- A prospective graduate must have completed a minimum of 25% of the required program course work at Pamlico Community College and meet the minimum requirements for the credential.
- A student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher to be awarded any credential.
- All financial obligations to the College must be paid before a student can be awarded any credential.
