### **Terminology**

- Gateway course: ex. ENG 111 or MAT 143
- **Co-requisite course:** ex. ENG 011 or MAT 043
- Transition course: ex. BSP 4002 (ENG 002) and BSP 4003 (MAT 003). Transition courses are taught and registered through Basic Skills (Con. Ed.)
- Tier 1 <u>passed</u> equals P1, Tier 2 passed equals P2 and so forth. R equals an <u>unsuccessful</u> attempt

#### **Placement**

- GPA is the first placement measure:
  - HS GPA within 10 years of enrollment date: No 10 year limit at this time.
  - Must have attended a US high school
  - No 4th math requirement
- Other placement measures:
  - SAT, ACT, GED, HISET, RISE Placement Test scores, and previous DRE/DMA work
  - Earned Associate Degree or higher (Bachelors/Masters/PhD) exempts the student from transition/co-req. courses

## **RISE Placement Test**

- Only individuals who meet the following requirements will be <u>allowed/required</u> to take the RISE Placement Test:
  - Students with GPA older than 10 years: Rule suspended for now.
  - Students without a GPA or Foreign students
  - GED students (GED < 170 on any tests)
  - HiSET score (< 15 on **any** of the subject tests or < 4 on the Essay)
  - Some homeschooled students
- Based on the students score, they will be placed in:
  - Gateway math course
  - Gateway English course
  - Gateway math course with co-requisite course
  - Gateway English course with co-requisite course
  - Transition English BSP 4002 (ENG 002) or Transition Math BSP 4003 (MAT 003) or both

- After summer 2020, DMA & DRE courses will no longer be offered.
  - To bypass BSP 4002 (ENG 002) Tier 1, you must have completed DRE 097 prior to the start of fall 2020.
  - To bypass BSP 4002 (ENG 002) Tier 1 & 2, you must have completed both DRE 097 & DRE 098 prior to the start of fall 2020.

- To bypass BSP 4003 (MAT 003) Tier 1, you must have completed through DMA 030 **prior** to the start of fall 2020.
- To bypass BSP 4003 (MAT 003) Tier 1 & 2, you must have completed through DMA 050 prior to the start of fall 2020.
- To bypass BSP 4003 (MAT 003) Tier 1-3, you must have completed through DMA 080 prior to the start of fall 2020.
- DMA & DRE course work will not be accepted for credit as of **fall 2025**.
