Apply to a NC community College of your choice
Complete pending Community College courses from Partnership Teach evaluation check sheet
Maintain Cumulative GPA of 2.5 for Part Time or 3.0 for Full Time

PASS PRAXIS CORE ACADEMIC SKILLS FOR EDUCATORS EXAM

Take Praxis Core Exam no later than October before applying to Partnership Teach
Composite passing score required is 468 (total of all exams); or ACT/SAT scores
